and inviting just as it was when
Chief Osceola of the Seminole
Indians hunted and fished here long

ago. Owned by the Makinson family
originally, the 132-acre island offers
3.5 miles of hiking trails and wildlife viewing. Located in the middle
of Lake Tohopekaliga, the island
housed exotic animals before the
state bought it in 1999. The island
is now a county park and is open
to the public. No rentals available.
